(250 hours- 1 week Theory, 5 Weeks Practical)**

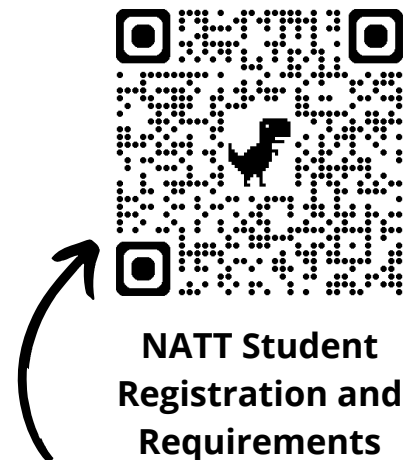
**PROGRAM OUTLINE:**

This program includes all mandatory objectives set forth in the Ministry of Transportation's Commercial Truck Driver Training Standard (Class A), released July 2017, plus additional objectives that exceeds the minimum standard. Our AZ Truck Driving Program includes 1 week of virtual class room training and 5 weeks of practical training. We provide our students with more practical training hours than most schools.

The Truck Training Schools Association of Ontario (TTSAO) Airbrake Course is included with this program, consisting of 12 Hr of training and then Practical testing all done on site.

**Subjects of the program include:**

- Employment in the Commercial Vehicle Industry
- Vehicle Components & Systems
- Basic Driving Techniques

\*Students are trained on Electronic Logging Device (ELD) for their hours of service, and utilize the ELD daily throughout their training like the Real World.

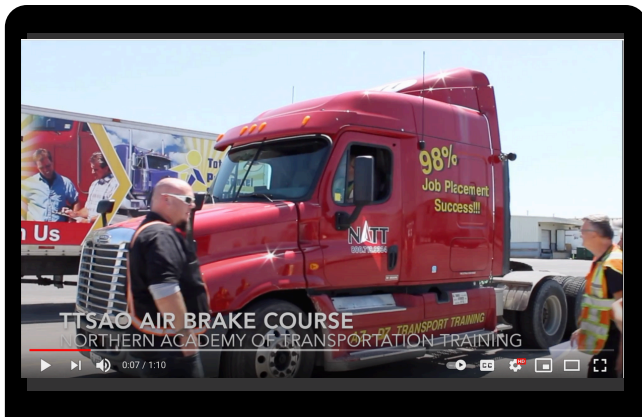


## AZ Program (continued)

This AZ program includes both classroom and practical training. The hands-on training takes place in the yard and on the road using a tractor-trailer, while under the instruction of a qualified trainer.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Must have minimum Grade 10 English (or equivalent)
- Must hold a valid Ontario Class G license or Higher
- MTO Medical that meets the vision, hearing and medical requirements for a class A licence,
- Drivers Abstract.

- Pass a Natt Personnel Solutions pre-hire road test
